- More targeted approach
- Steps aren't SMART
- Language/audience particularly with Obj 3

# **Community Key Findings**

- Sectors and services need to be linked together
- Cost of living
- Transport access to jobs, health, education, services
- Access to health care (GPs)
- Social prescribing (but 3<sup>rd</sup> sector need support)
- Easier to access funding
- Communities are reuniting
- Levels of apathy/disinterest
