Objectives

- **We want to create a fair and equitable Gwent for all.**
- **We want to create a Gwent that has friendly, safe and confident communities.**
- **We want to create a Gwent where the natural environment is protected and enhanced.**

General points

- Public services need to work better together
- Welsh language and culture missing
- Language used
- The objectives are equally important
- Links between and across the objectives
- Do fewer things well (21 steps is too many)
- Links between PSB, RPB and other initiatives
- Engagement is still difficult

Survey Key Findings

- Objectives will improve well-being
- Cost of living crisis
 - Energy
 - Food
 - Transport
 - Jobs
 - Housing
- Impacts of poverty on everyone
- Community empowerment and action

Stakeholder Key Findings

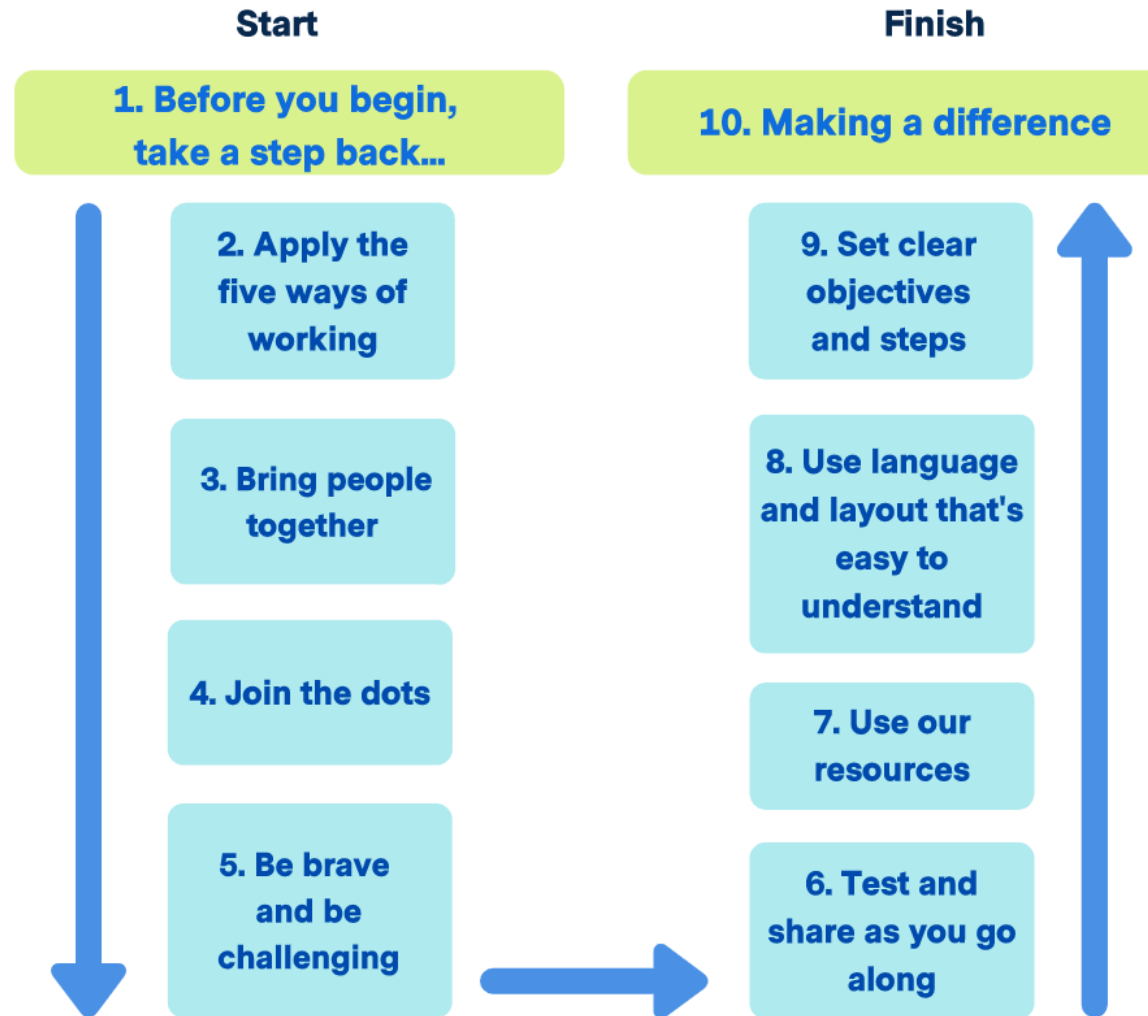
- Overlaps between steps and objectives
- More targeted approach
- Steps aren't SMART
- Language/audience – particularly with Obj 3

Community Key Findings

- Sectors and services need to be linked together
- Cost of living
- Transport – access to jobs, health, education, services
- Access to health care (GPs)
- Social prescribing (but 3rd sector need support)
- Easier to access funding
- Communities are reuniting
- Levels of apathy/disinterest
